

Child Abuse and Sex Crimes Division

If you suspect that a child is being abused, abandoned or neglected, call 911 or contact the **Oklahoma Child Protective Services at (800) 522-3511.**

Mandated Reporters include doctors, nurses, and medical providers; therapists, social workers, alcohol and substance abuse counselors, and mental health providers; teachers, school administrators, school aides, daycare workers, and residential care workers; clergy and law enforcement personnel. Mandated reporters **must** make reports when they have reasonable cause to suspect that a child before them in their official capacity is an abused or maltreated child.

If you believe someone is in imminent danger, you are always instructed to call 911. If you do not believe anyone is in imminent danger, then you should report your suspicions to the police agency in the city where the acts occurred.
