Polls will be open Tuesday, November 9, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., for special elections in Luther and Spencer, but other voting options are available.

The Oklahoma County Election Board can accept absentee ballot applications from eligible voters who want an absentee ballot mailed to them until 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 2, 2021.

After the November 2 mail absentee ballot deadline, eligible voters who want to vote absentee may still receive and cast a ballot by going to the County Election Board office located at 4201 N. Lincoln Boulevard in Oklahoma City on Thursday, November 4 or Friday November 5 from 8 a.m. until 6 p.m.
