## PREPARING FOR HEARING BEFORE THE BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

Evidence that may be helpful in the appeal process is listed below:

- 1. Current photographs of the property under appeal and/or the surrounding area.
- 2. A recent real estate appraisal.
- 3. Real estate purchase contract, settlement statement, or closing statement if the property was purchased recently.
- 4. Comparable values or sales in the area. You can contact a realtor for recent sales. You may also contact the Assessor for a list of the comparables used in assessing your property. You can also visit the Assessor's Web Site for all sales in the area. www.oklahomacounty.org
- 5. Brokers market analysis.
- 6. Realtor letter of market analysis.
- 7. If rental property is under appeal, a lease agreement, income statement and IRS income tax depreciation schedule.
- 8. If you would like to visit the Assessor's website for property assessments in your neighborhood you can go to <a href="https://www.oklahomacounty.org">www.oklahomacounty.org</a> then click on property assessments, accept the agreement than just enter a name or address of property.
- 9. NOTE: If you have someone serve as your personal representative, you will need to file a letter of authorization with the Board of Equalization prior to your hearing. Forms are available upon request.
- 10. NOTE: If you are representing a taxpayer and/or have filed an appeal on behalf of a taxpayer, you will need to file a letter of authorization with the Board of Equalization prior to your hearing. Forms are available upon request.
