Polls will be open Tuesday, June 30, 2020 for Federal, State, County and Special Elections from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., but other voting options are available.

The Oklahoma County Election Board can accept absentee ballot applications from registered voters who want an absentee ballot mailed to them until 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 23, 2020.

After the June 23 mail absentee ballot deadline, registered voters who want to vote absentee may still receive and cast a ballot by going to the County Election Board office located at 4201 N. Lincoln Boulevard in Oklahoma City from 8 a.m. until 6 p.m. on Thursday, June 25, and Friday, June 26 and from 9 a.m. until 2 p.m. on Saturday, June 27.

A two-member, bipartisan Absentee Voting Board will be on duty those days to assist in-person absentee voters.
